Richmond Junior Senior High School 1941 - 1966

- 800 - 900 pupil capacity with 26 teachers and one part-time secretary.
- School Inspector for the High School was Mr. Sullivan.
- States it was an ideal school - explains this.
- Largest school in B.C. with Japanese population until the evacuation.
- How the war affected the student population.
- The P.T.A. that existed is replaced by School Board purchasing equipment.
- Talks of different teaching methods he used.
- Introduced the "floater marks".
- Talks of English as a subject.
- New High School; built in 1952 resulting in enlarged curriculum and counselling was introduced.
- Explains counselling - educational, vocational and social, and the role of the councillor.
- Opinions of the future of education.
